## **BACKGROUND**

The Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA) is the Gambia's independent multi-sector regulator established under the PURA Act 2001 to regulate the following sectors:

- Broadcasting
- Electricity
- Telecommunications (Mobile, Landline, ISP)
- Petroleum (Downstream)
- Water and Sewage
- Transportation
- Post

PURA in accordance with its mandate is currently striving toward performing technical, economical and safety regulatory functions with respect to regulated public services. This is done in a bid to achieve its regulatory mandate and fair competition within the regulated entities to promote economic development, social inclusion, and environmental sustainability to improve service delivery and protection for consumers and service providers.

## **Job Summary**

Report to the Director Petroleum Energy and Water, the Senior Petroleum Manager would be responsible for ensuring compliance with the current regulatory procedures and updating the procedures when new regulatory requirements become effective for smooth implementation, and enforcement of standards in the downstream petroleum sector.

## **Responsibilities**

- Administer the quality control requirements for petroleum products being imported and sold through the current inspection regimes in accordance with specifications and the regulations
- Oversee and maintain quarterly monitoring of all fuel stations and ensure safety of operations in accordance with HSE Guidelines and regulations.
- Monitor wet stock data reporting and provide analysis for intervention to maintain security of supply of fuel in the country
- Coordinate the HSE and quality inspection activities of the Petroleum Inspectors
- Participate in the resolution and enforcement of inspection observations and findings.
- Initiate measures to prevent the occurrence of quality control deficiencies and defective work through a rigorous monitoring regime.
- Develop additional quality procedures as required to cover special quality tests, HSE audits, to improve construction monitoring of new downstream infrastructure
