BACKGROUND

The Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA) is the Gambia's independent multi-sector regulator established under the PURA Act 2001 to regulate the following sectors:

- Broadcasting
- Electricity
- Telecommunications (Mobile, Landline, ISP)
- Petroleum (Downstream)
- Water and Sewage
- Transportation
- Post

PURA in accordance with its mandate is currently striving toward performing technical, economical and safety regulatory functions with respect to regulated public services. This is done in a bid to achieve its regulatory mandate and fair competition within regulated entities to promote economic development, social inclusion, and environmental sustainability to improve service delivery and protection for consumers and service providers.

Scope of Work

Responsible for assisting in the processing of all applications related to access and backhaul microwave frequencies. He/she is expected to assist in managing the spectrum usage for MNOs, ISPs and all other spectrum users in terms of resolution of interferences, monitoring, developing guidelines, conducting inspections, etc.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Maintain Frequency Register and database system for all spectrum assignments related to the microwave and access bands for the various networks
- Coordinating and maintaining technical specifications and equipment standards for Mobile services
- Populate and manage the spectrum management software
- Plan and organise monitoring and enforcement activities for frequencies relating to the spectrum users in accordance with laid down procedures and regulations
- Assist in analysing access and microwave spectrum data from Service Providers
- Assist in generating access and microwave spectrum invoices to Service Providers
- Assist in verifying access and microwave spectrum data of Service Providers
- Assist in the development of responses to ITU circulars, Notices and coordination with neighbouring countries
- Assist in the development and updating of national frequency allocation table post World Radiocommunications Conference (WRCs)
- Assist in frequency management planning, development of guidelines and coordinate the use of frequencies with neighbouring countries

- Assist in research to determine existing and future radio communications needs of the country and to make the necessary recommendations
- Assist with Type Approval Certification processing
- Assist in ITU notifications of live service stations
- Assist in providing all necessary information concerning spectrum management for the update of the PURA website
- Make presentations as directed
- Any other duties that may be assigned from time-to-time.
